Job purpose

Your purpose is to work as part of a team to maintain a safe and successful operation. You will diligently care for all the company's equipment and assist in operations.

As a first line company representative, your major focus is on adhering to standard operating procedures, performing preventative and corrective maintenance, and troubleshooting equipment.

You work closely with fellow technicians and report directly to the Operations Supervisors.

Duties and responsibilities

- 1. Troubleshoot, repair, maintain and calibrate equipment such as: pumps and motors, valves, meters, gas detection equipment, fire suppression system and instrumentation
- 2. Maintain and repair electrical equipment
- 3. Conduct routine quality inspections of all tanks, skids, pipelines and structures at all NGC facilities
- 4. Report on conditions/actions that could negatively impact safe operations
- 5. Participate in safety and toolbox talks and execute tasks as assigned
- 6. Ensure full compliance with all Standard Operating Procedures
- 7. Ensure that all health and safety standards and practices are complied with in all work-related activities
- 8. Contribute to the ongoing development and refinement of all operations and maintenance strategies and demonstrate commitment to those implemented
- 9. Perform required duties in operations such as Ship Unloading, Tank Inventory Management, Product Blending and Truck Loading and Unloading
- 10. Execute cargo transfers according to loading / discharge plans
- 11. Take daily temperature, pressure and liquid level readings of the storage tanks and record.
- 12. Perform daily inventory reconciliation and custody transfer reconciliation
- 13. Participate in specific annual training in the areas of loading and discharging from ships and trucks, pipeline operations, tank gauging, firefighting, etc.
